Search all years (1759 to present), a specific date, or a range of years


## Publication (Location)

- (1) Selecting a **Country** makes it possible to narrow the search to a specific **State** or **Province**; then,
- (2) selecting a **State** enables limiting by city;
- (3) selecting a **City** will then permit
- (4) selecting a specific newspaper **Title**

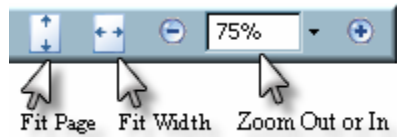

# It's easy to print just the part you want!

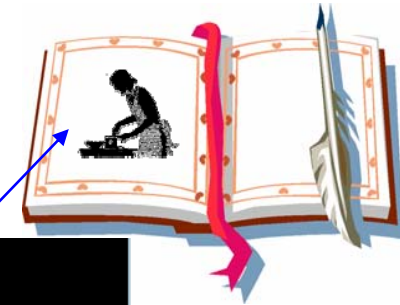
- 1 Use the **Zoom** or **Fit Page** or **Fit Width** tools to enlarge the item for viewing or printing

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## Food Editor Conducts Co

### GREEN TOMATO HAS MANY USES AS SHOWN HERE

What can green tomatoes be used for, beside picallili or relish?

Ever try fried green tomatoes, or green tomato pie? These are only two of a dozen or more excellent recipes for using green tomatoes which have been worked out by students in the home economics department at the University of Wisconsin. They discovered that the green fruit combines very well with milk or egg, with lima beans, onion, cheese, lemon, brown sugar, potato and corn, and some very delicious combinations were worked out. Green tomatoes are rich in vitamin C, just as is the red, ripe fruit.

**Easily Prepared**

Fried green tomatoes are easily prepared and make an excellent vegetable dish. The green tomatoes are cut into half-inch slices, sprinkled with salt, dipped in flour or fine bread crumbs, and fried until tender in a little fat. Sliced onions may be fried along with the tomatoes to add flavor.

Stewed green tomatoes and cream of green tomato soup are prepared just as are the regulation ripe tomato dishes of the same name. Green tomato marmalade, too, is as simply made as the usual ripe tomato marmalade. For six pounds of green tomatoes, six cups of sugar and six lemons are used. The tomatoes are washed, trimmed and cut into small pieces, and then the sugar is added to them. The lemons are cut into very thin slices and boiled for about five minutes in one cup of water. This is added to the tomato and sugar, and the mixture is cooked with constant stirring until it has the consistency of thick jam.

**May Be Canned**

Green tomatoes may also be canned just as are red tomatoes, except that no salt should be added. The salt tends to destroy the vitamin C to some extent, it has been found by Wisconsin nutrition workers. Scalding the green fruit to remove the skins and then canning it by the usual cold pack method and processing it for 25 minutes has been found the most satisfactory method.

These canned tomatoes can then be used in soups, in vegetable dishes or in desserts. Green tomato pie, near relative of lemon pie, is one of the most popular of the recipes de-
